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Short steep walk to superb views

S From the small car park in the middle of Benderloch go E into the woods (signed 'Eagles' Eyrie' & 'Coastal Climb') to reach a path junction. Go NE (left - 'red/blue' route) to initially follow a level path through trees behind some houses before bearing SW (sharp right) to climb steeply. The path gains height quickly & almost straight away offers glimpses of the view through the trees. Continue to climb past a bench to reach a fork to the left of a view point & 2nd bench. (3/4 km)

① Continue S (straight-on - 'red' route)  
climbing more gently up through the trees past  
a 3rd bench to reach a signed fork. 
$$(1/2 \text{ km})$$

(2) Go N (left - signed 'Eagle's Eyrie Viewpoint'). This is a dead end path but is well worth the extra effort as it allows a west facing view over Lynn of Lorn with the Islands of Lismore & Mull beyond. (1/4 km)

③ Retrace yours steps back to the signed junction. (1/4 km)

(4) Continue NE (left - signed 'Beinn Lora summit') gently climbing to reach a track. Cross & continue NE past a Lochan (right) to reach a 4th bench. Bear S (right) round the Lochan before gently climbing up through the trees to reach a picnic table & a gate giving access to the open hillside. (3/4 km)

(5) Go through & follow the path beyond generally ESE across a shallow bealach (can be boggy) before climbing to the summit of Beinn Lora (trig point, views south towards Oban, east towards Ben Cruachan & north towards Glencoe). (1/2 km)

(6) Retrace your steps all the way back to the path junction at point (1).  $(1^{3}/_{4} \text{ km})$ 

(7) Go SW (left - 'red/blue' route) & descend through the trees to return to the car park & the start. (<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> km)


