

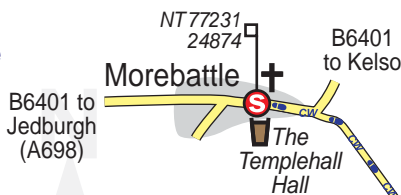


bo124 Hownam Law from Morebattle

At weekends and school holidays there is ample parking space outside the village school at the W end of Morebattle village.

The walk shown is for guidance only and should not be attempted without suitable maps.

Superb, extensive views over the Merse of Scotland and the Border hills

➊ Go E through the village to a road junction signed 'St Cuthbert's Way'. Go SE (right) over a hill to a 2nd road junction. Go S (right - 'St Cuthbert's Way') and follow the road for 500m to a footbridge over the Kale Water. (1¾ km)

➋ Go E (left) over the bridge and follow waymarked posts S (right) for a short way then NE (left) to a stile. Climb steeply uphill to a gate. Follow St Cuthbert's Way on a rising traverse that heads NE towards Grubbit Law. (1½ km)

➌ Bear ESE (right) climbing steeply again to a col NE of Grubbit Law, and then NE (left) up another short steep section to reach and cross a stile. Go SE (right), leaving St Cuthbert's Way to follow a fence down over a small hill before climbing to Cushat End. (1½ km)

➍ Go SSW (right) and follow the fence to a junction with a gate in the corner. Go through and climb steeply W (right) and then SW (left) through a 2nd gate to reach the summit of Hownam Law (trig point, large fort). (1½ km)

➎ Go S, descending steeply at first, to join an old track. Go SW (right) on the track to the ruined buildings at South Cote. (1 km)

➏ Continue SW through pastures to join a short section of lane and the farm buildings at Howgate. (1¾ km)

➐ At Howgate go W (right) to reach a tarmac road. Go N (right) and follow the road to join the outward route at the footbridge. (¾ km)

➑ Continue N and retrace your steps back to Morebattle and the start. (¾ km)

NB. The section from Grubbit Law to Howgate is not on official rights of way. (The local farmers seem friendly enough though!)

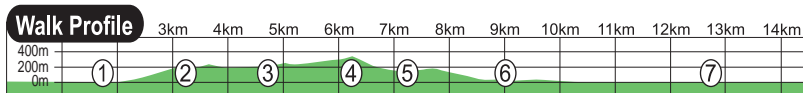
