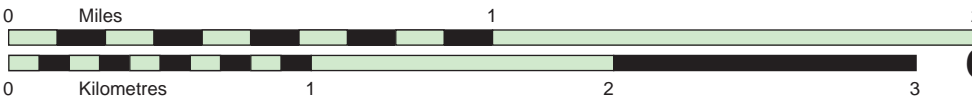


gm101 The Bridgewater Canal from Dunham Town

Dunham Town is on minor roads E of Lymm and S of Altrincham

Pleasant canal side stroll

① From St Mark's Church, Dunham Town go N on School Lane past the Axe & Cleaver to reach the Bridgewater Canal. Cross the bridge and go down to the towpath. Go SW on the canal towpath to Agden Bridge (4½ km).

② At Agden Bridge leave the towpath and cross over the canal. Go SE at a junction, and then E on the old A56 signed 'No Through Road'. Continue E on A56 to reach 'Ye Olde No. 3'. Go S on the path opposite 'Ye Olde No. 3' to cross fields before bearing E along a track to pass between several glass houses before reaching Arthill Farm. Continue E across the road passing on the N edge of woodland. Go N across a field to stile. Go N to track and then N on Spode Green Lane to reach the A56. (2½ km)

③ Go NW on the A56 for 250m then N on a signed path to New Farm. After 50m, go NW on a signed path, over 2 stiles to reach a track. Cross the track and continue NW over more stiles to reach the 'Swan with Two Nicks'. (1km)

④ Turn E along road, crossing a footbridge over a mill stream and continue E on a track to reach Dunham Park. Go E through Dunham Park to reach the road at Smithy Gate. Turn E for 20m then N to return to Dunham Town and the start. (1½ km)
