

ny107 Moor Gate from Hawnby

Hawnby is on minor roads W of the B1257 Helmsley to Stokesley Road

The walk shown is for guidance only and should not be attempted without suitable maps.

Pleasant country stroll

① Go W on the road through Hawnby village before going NW (right) on a signed track opposite Manor Farm. Climb gently up the track that slowly bears N past Hill End House and then a gate. Continue N on the track which slowly bears NNE toward Bilsdale TV Mast to reach a road at Moor Gate. (2km)

② Cross the road and go ENE on the right of two tracks to reach Sportsman's Hall (an isolated farmhouse). Follow recent yellow waymarks through the farm (between the farmhouse and a barn) and then down through trees to a footbridge over Ladhill Beck. Ascend SE up the opposite side (look out for yellow waymarks on the rocks) crossing a track and gently climbing to a wall stile. Continue SE beyond on a clear path that soon joins a wall near a gate. (1¹/₂ km)

③ Don't go through the gate but bear E (left) with the wall on your right to follow a clear path that heads E and then S before continuing SE round the base of Easterside Hill. Ignore a stile on your right and continue beside the wall/fence (still on your right) to descend to a road. (1¹/₂ km)

④ Go S (right) on the road and follow it when it bears W back to Hawnby and the start. (2¹/₂ km)

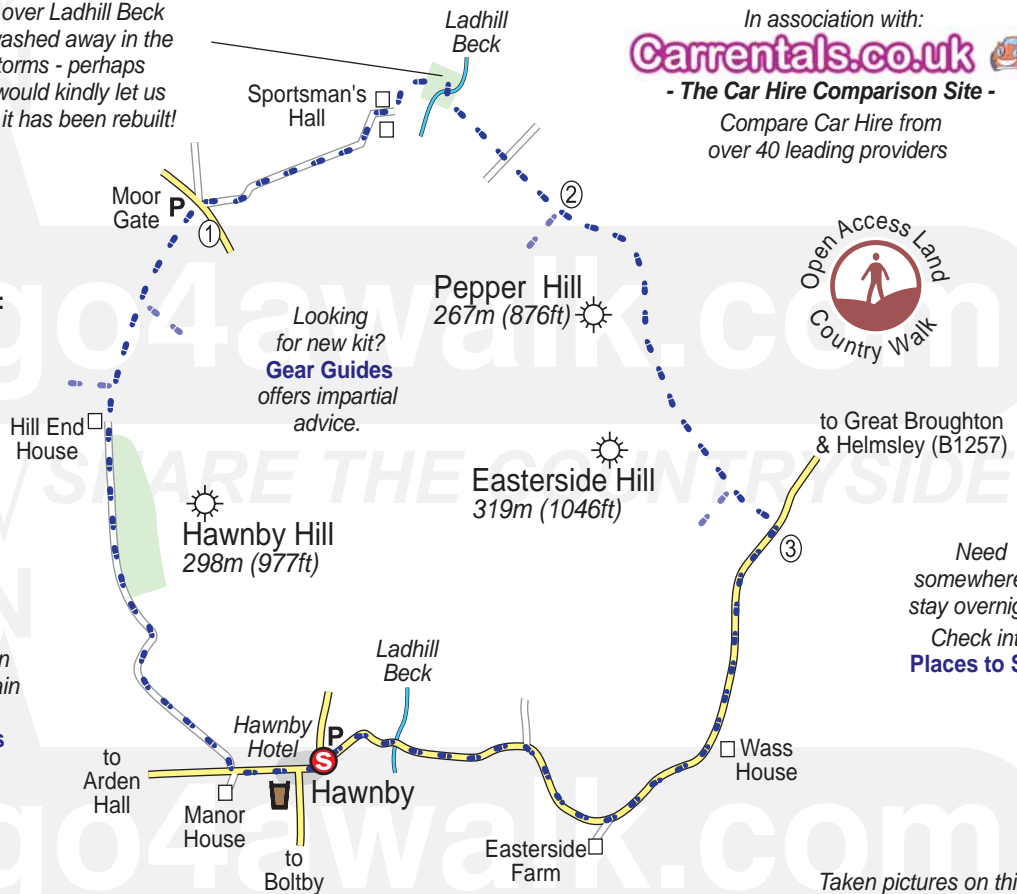
Note: We've had reports that the bridge over Ladhill Beck has been washed away in the recent storms - perhaps someone would kindly let us know when it has been rebuilt!
