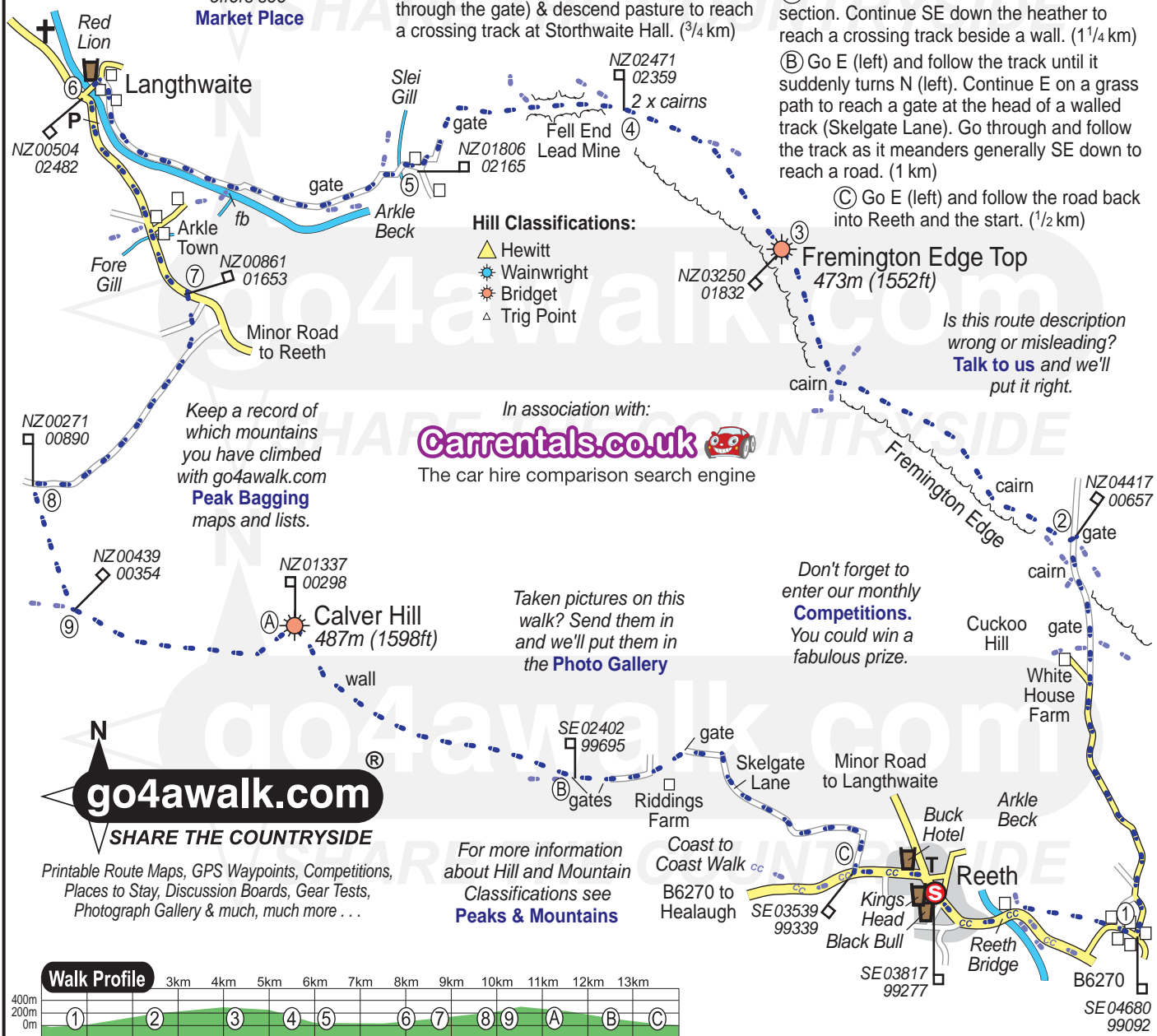

Fine fine views

- ① Go N (left) up a narrow lane. Continue N through a gate and past White House Farm to reach a gate at the top. (1³/₄ km)
- ② Go NW along Fremington Edge to reach the highest point - Fremington Edge Top (cairn). (1³/₄ km)
- ③ Continue NW gently descending to join a bridleway and then reach 2 cairns (1 large, 1 small). (1¹/₄ km)
- ④ Bear W (half-left) down through the spoil heaps to reach a gate on your left. Go S (left through the gate) & descend pasture to reach a crossing track at Storthwaite Hall. (3³/₄ km)

- ⑤ Go W and follow the track over a footbridge and then beside the Arkle Beck through woodland to emerge in Langthwaite. (1³/₄ km)
- ⑥ Go SW (left) over the beck & then SSE (left) on a minor road past a car park, through Arkle Town and up to a cattle grid. (3³/₄ km)
- ⑦ Leave the road and go S (right) on a bridleway that climbs the hillside. Cross one track and bear SW (half-left) on a 2nd for 700m to reach a junction. (1 km)
- ⑧ Go SSE (left) on a bridleway gently up the grass (the path soon disappears) to reach a clear crossing path on a shallow col. (1/2 km)
- ⑨ Go ESE (left) along the side of the ridge before climbing steeply up the grass to reach the summit of Calver Hill (cairn, cross). (1 km)
- A Go SE down to reach & follow a 200m wall section. Continue SE down the heather to reach a crossing track beside a wall. (1¹/₄ km)
- B Go E (left) and follow the track until it suddenly turns N (left). Continue E on a grass path to reach a gate at the head of a walled track (Skelgate Lane). Go through and follow the track as it meanders generally SE down to reach a road. (1 km)
- C Go E (left) and follow the road back into Reeth and the start. (1/2 km)

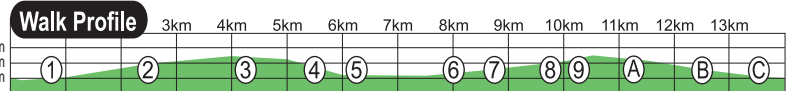
