



po108 Pen Cerrig-calch & Pen Allt-mawr from Neuadd-fawr

Neuadd-fawr is on minor roads N of Llanbedr & Crickhowell

The walk shown is for guidance only and should not be attempted without suitable maps.

Fine views in all directions

Ⓢ From the car park go W back across the road bridge and over a waymarked stile to the left of a gate. Climb SW up a field to reach the drive to Ty-Croes Farm. Cross and continue SW and then W up the field opposite to reach a crossing path on the open hillside beyond the intake wall. Continue W gently climbing across the fell for 600m to reach a path junction by a single tree. Bear SW (half-left) up steep grass on an intermittent path that leads up through rocks and scree before crossing more level ground to reach the summit of Pen Cerrig-calch (trig point, shelter). (2km)

- ① Continue NW across the flat top before descending to a cairn. Continue N on a clear path across Pen Gloch-y-pibwr before climbing gently to the summit of Pen allt-mawr (trig point). (2½ km)
- ② Bear NNE steeply down an easy path and then N along a more level ground on a clear path that bends NE and then E at a fork to reach Pen Twyn Glas (cairn). (1¼ km)
- ③ Go S and then SE gently descending the Tal Trwynau ridge to reach a tall cairn. (2½ km)
- ④ Bear ESE down steeper ground to reach a gate. Go through and follow the edge of a forest round one corner before leaving it to head SE down a field to join a track and then a gate. Go through and follow the walled track down to a junction above Neuadd-fawr Farm. Go W (right) into a field and then follow waymarks down to a stile. Cross to reach a road and the start. (1¾ km)

GPS data: Position Format = 'British Grid'
Map Datum = 'ord svy GB'

NB. Car parking at Neuadd-fawr is very limited and there have been a number of cases where farmers with tractors and forestry lorries have not been able to pass. There is car parking for about 5 cars only in the lay by at the bridge, but cars should not be parked on the side of the road or on the Crickhowell side of the bridge at all. Walkers will continue to receive the support of farmers if they are more considerate.

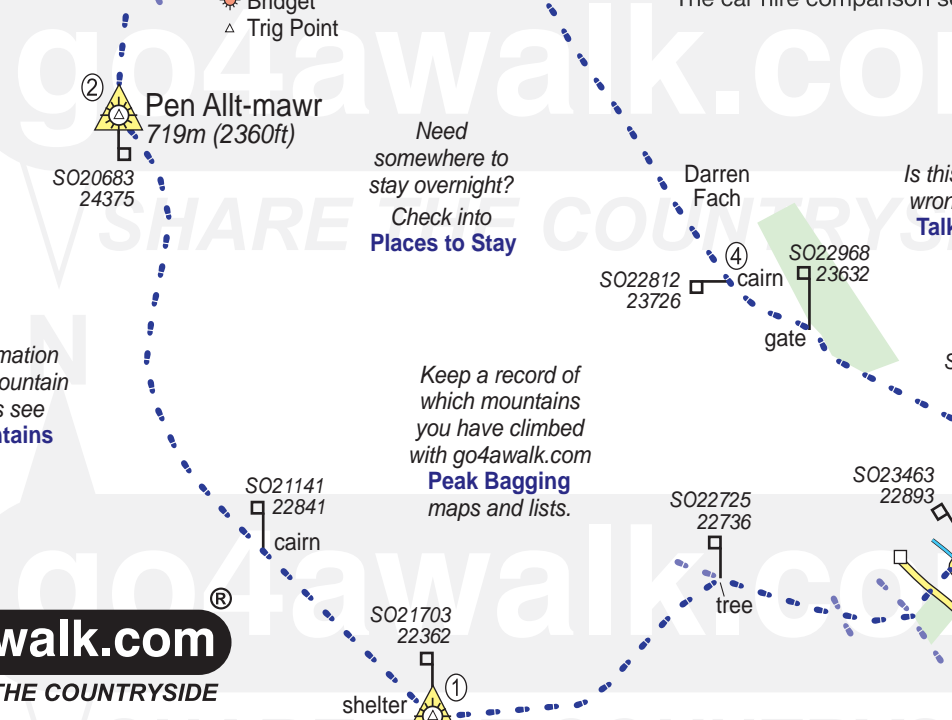

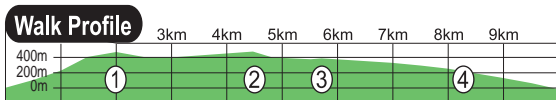
