GPS data: Position Format = 'British Grid'

- ⑤ Go NNE (right) over a stile & across a field to reach a culvert/bridge. Cross & continue NNE towards Wettenhall Hall Farm before bearing NE (half-right) to a hedge stile. Continue NE to a stile in a field corner. (¾ km)
- ⑥ Go ESE (right) diagonally across the next field & then follow waymarks across several fields to reach the access road to Bankside Farm. Go ENE (left) on it to a junction. (1¼ km)
- ⑦ Go SSE (right) descending to a bridge & then SE (left) at the next junction towards the huge Darnhall Radio Telescope. Before reaching the Telescope go S (right) across a field to a hedge stile. Cross & go ENE (left) & then SSE (right) again following the edge of several fields to a T-junction. (1½ km)
- ⑧ Go ENE (left) to reach a grassy lane. Go S (right) on the lane to reach a road at Paradise Farm. Go S (right) on the lane to reach the access road to Paradise Green. (1 km)
- ⑨ Go E & retrace your steps back to Sunnyside & a road. (1¾ km)
- A Go SSE (right) back to Church Minshull & the start. (1¼ km)

Quiet country lanes

From The Badger Inn, go NE (left) on the B5074 to a junction. Bear NNNW (left) with the B5074 for 200m to reach a bridge over a stream. (¼ km)

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The 25-metre MERLIN Darnhall Radio Telescope is part of an array of six observing stations that together form a powerful telescope with an effective aperture of over 217 kilometres. The base telescope is either the Lovell Telescope or the Mark II at Jodrell Bank. Merlin stands for the Multi-Element Radio-Linked Interferometer Network.
