



# so110 Beacon Batch from Cheddar Gorge

The walk shown is for guidance only and should not be attempted without suitable maps.

Black Rock Car Park is at the E (upper) end of Cheddar Gorge, on the B3135 Cheddar to Priddy Road

## Details

Distance: 12km (7½ miles)  
Total Ascent: 242m (794ft)

## A stroll in the Mendips

From the Parking Area go E through a gate to follow the West Mendip Way gently E, N (left) & NE (right) up through Black Rock Valley Nature Reserve. (1 km)

① Follow the main path (West Mendip Way) as it bears N (left) through a gate to climb NW through Long Wood Nature Reserve. Cross a stile & continue WNW along field edges to reach a farm access road. (1½ km)

② Go N (right) on the access road to a lane. (¾ km)

③ Turn W (left) and follow the lane until it bends WNW (slightly right) about 200m before Tynings Farm & Trekking Centre. (¾ km)

④ Leave the Mendip Way and go N (right) to follow a (re-routed) path N & then NE between fields to reach a gate. Go through and follow a clear path NE (half right) across open moorland to reach a fork. Bear ENE (half-right) and continue ENE across the 1st crossing path to reach a 2nd (a sunken ditch). Go E (half-right) to the summit of Beacon Batch (trig point). (2 km)

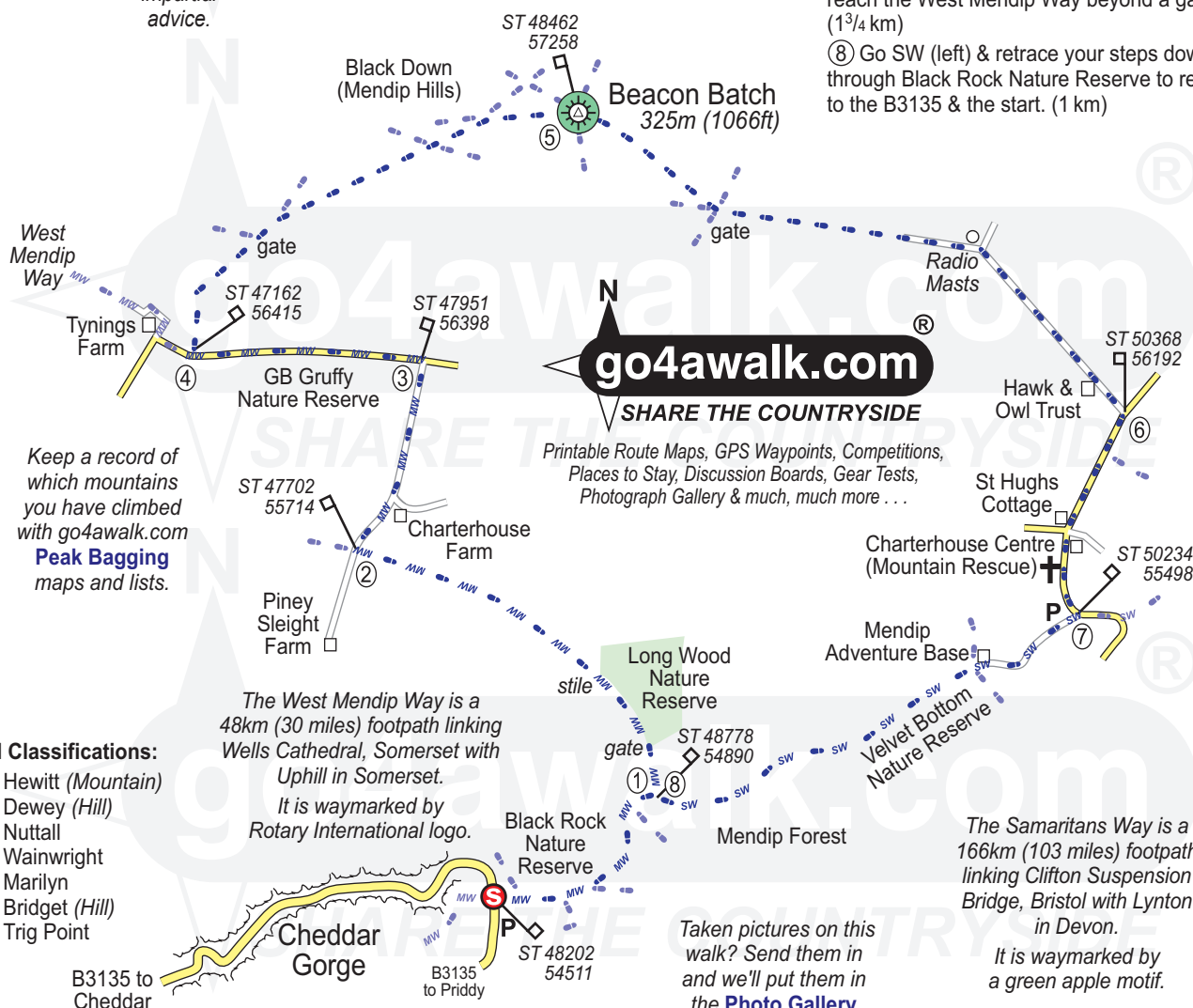
⑤ Continue SE down the other side aiming for a radio mast to reach a gate. Go through and follow the track past the mast to a junction. Go SE (right) down the access road to reach a lane. (2½ km)

⑥ Go SSW (right) on the lane and follow it across a junction & down to reach a signed path just beyond a left-hand bend. (¾ km)

⑦ Go SW (right) through a gate & descend through Velvet Bottom Nature Reserve to reach the West Mendip Way beyond a gate. (1¾ km)

⑧ Go SW (left) & retrace your steps down through Black Rock Nature Reserve to return to the B3135 & the start. (1 km)

It is waymarked by Rotary International logo.

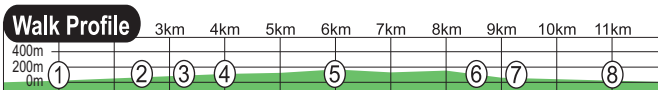
