Shakespeare country

Go E from Shakespeare's statue & then SE past Cox's Yard (on your left) across the River Avon via the brick 'Tramway Bridge' following 'Butterfly' signs. The pathway crosses a road & soon bears S past the Butterfly Farm to run parallel to the A3400. Cross the A4390 & continue S on the tramway to reach the B4632 (signed 'Broadway', 'Mickleton' & 'Clifford Chambers'). (1½ km)

- Go SW (right) for 200m to the entrance to Cross-o-th-Hill Farm. Go S (left) over the stile opposite & take the right-hand of two paths to diagonally cross a field. (½ km)
- Bear W (right - signed 'Clifford 1¼') around a clinic before going SW (left) along the edge of fields to reach Clifford Park. Go through a gate & continue SW for 100m to reach a 'crossroads'. (¾ km)
- Go NW (right) to pass a school & reach the B4632. (¼ km)
- Go SW (left) on the B4632 for 200m before forking right towards Weston & Welford. (¼ km)
- Almost immediately go W (right) on a track signed 'Milcote Hall' & follow it past farms & across the water treatment works access road to reach a dismantled railway track 'The Greenway'. (2¼ km)

- Go NE (right) on The Greenway crossing the River Stour to reach & cross the River Avon. (¾ km)
- Follow the riverside path. Beyond a road bridge, join a lane to reach Holy Trinity Church. Continue N beyond the church bearing right through 'RSC gardens' & around the RSC Theatre before returning the start. (2¾ km)

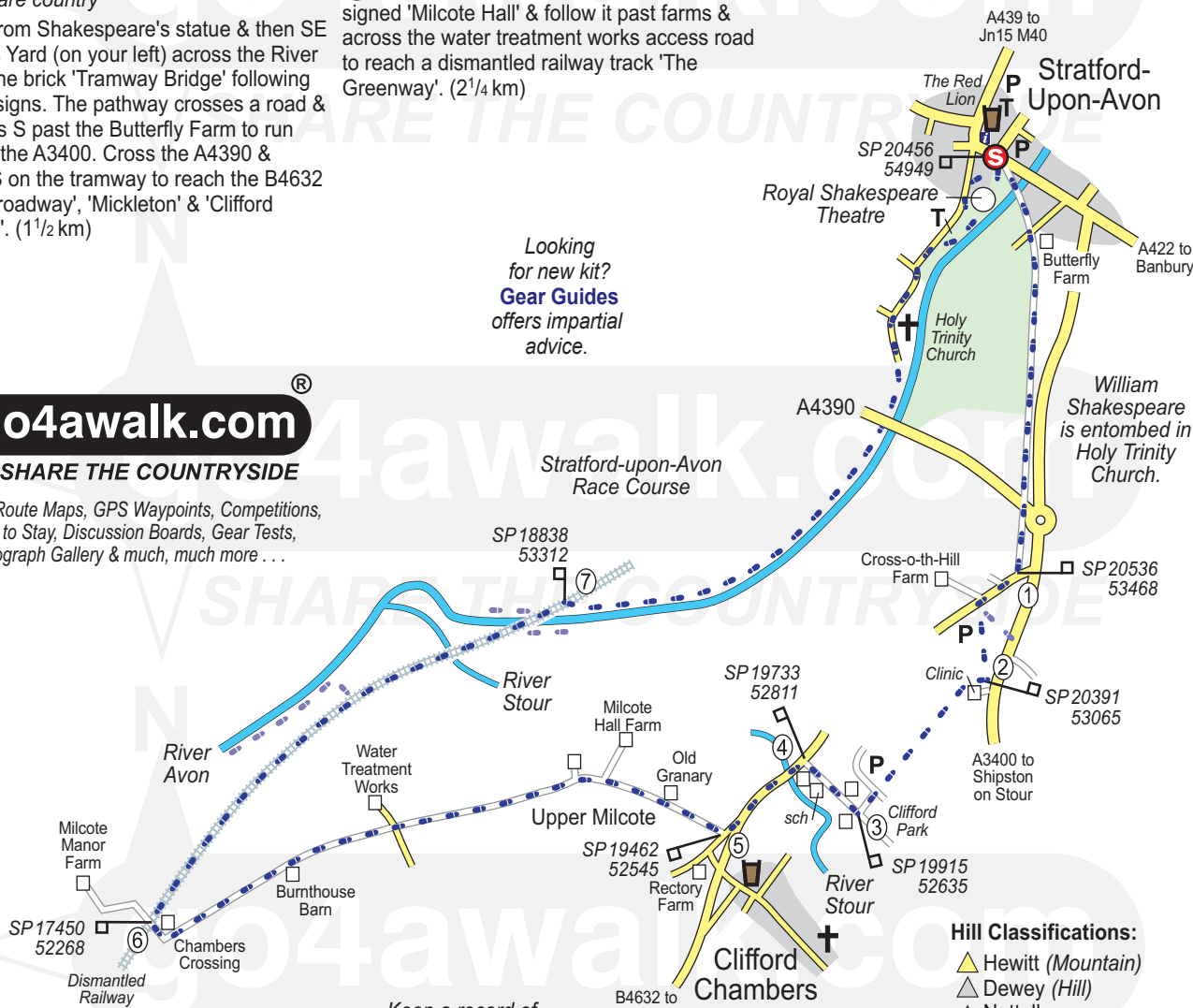

Stratford-upon-Avon Race Course

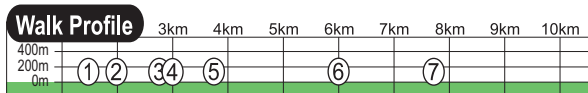
